Most families have had no choice but to turn their backs and show them tough love. (Enabling can result in a family destroying addiction also). Sometimes the family of addicts in active addiction must give their love one over to God through prayer. (We must take our hands off and allow God to put his hands on).

These suffering addicts have nothing and some have only the clothes on their backs.

INTRY FEE'S to recovery centers can be costly. Some require a onetime up-front fee and others a monthly tuition.

Most centers require three to five days of clothing

Some of these potential students need personal hygiene from soap to shaving cream, women's feminine products, and exedra.
